The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions:-

- 1. The affiliation Code Number allotted to your school is **1130764** This may please be noted and c further correspondence with the Board.
- 2. The school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT/CBSE and tex publishing by NCERT/CBSE. The school will follow syllabus and courses as per scheme of studie the Board for Secondary/Sr. Secondary School Examination and changes made therein from time
- 3. The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective from time to time.
- 4. The school must submit it's information through Online Affiliated School Information Systems per the Board's Circular No. CBSE/Aff.4/Circular/2016, dated 10.11.2016, within 30 days from the grant letter. Link for OASIS is available on Board's website: www.cbse.nic.in
- 5. The school will enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under :-

- (d) School running on bigger campus of more than 02 acres, the number of students shall be the actual facilities in the school which shall be proportionate to the optimum number menand (c) above.
- (e) Schools running on less than 01 acre campus in metropolitan cities shall restrict numb follows:-

6. The school will provide well equipped Laboratories, Library and other facilities as per norms of the relevant books to the academic level of students to be made available in the library and would kee books per student subject to a minimum of 1500 books excluding text books.

- 7. The school will also abide itself by the conditions of affiliation already prescribed by the State Governn
- 8. The school is required to restrict the number of sections as per the infrastructure facilities available in 1 rule 10.6 of Affiliation Bye-laws, the number of students in the class should not be very large. The opti students in a section of a class should not be more than 40 and number of students at middle, second secondary level of the school shall preferably be proportionate to each other.
- 9. School should have at least one adequately equipped computer lab with a minimum of 10 computers a computer student ratio of 1:20 at least. Proper software along with facility of Broad Band connectivity of internet always on from any service provider to be ensured.
- 10. **The section teacher ratio of 1:1.5** is to be maintained to teach various subjects and school shall approximately trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.
- 11. The school and its records shall be open for inspection by an officer/official of the Board or an authoriz of the Board/State Educational Department at any time and the school shall furnish information as ma the Board/State Government from time to time.
- 12. The accounts should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statem prepared in the name of school, as per rules. A copy each of the Statements of Accounts should be se every year.
- 13. The school will strictly adhere with all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting and Tra Further, school will provide adequate facilities for potable drinking water and clean healthy and hygien washing facilities for boys and girls separately in proportion to the number of students.
- 14. Fees should normally be charged under the heads prescribed by the Department of Education of the schools of different categories. **No capitation fee or voluntary donations** for gaining admission in the any other purpose should be charged / collected in the name of the school and the school should not or his or her parents or guardians to any screening procedure in accordance with Rule No. 11.1, 2 & 3 Chapter II, Rule No. 11.1 of Affiliation Bye-Laws, fees charges should be commensurate with the facility the institution.
- 15. The school should not use the activities for commercialization:
 - a) As per rule no. 19.1 (ii) It shall ensure that the school is run as a community service and not as a commercialization does not take place in the school in any shape whatsoever.
 - b) <u>As per rule no. 19.1 (ii)a</u> Any franchisee school making payment on account of use of name, franchiser institution or any other non-academic activities would be termed as commercialization c provide an affidavit that the school/society has not entered into any such contract to use Nam consideration of fee.
- 16. Teachers are to be made educated regarding **corporal punishment** & should avoid any type of such accordance with rule no. 44.1 (d & e).
- 17. School will not prepare any student/ start class for **any other Board** except CBSE from their CBSE at building/ premises.
- 18. **Admission to the school** is to be made restricted under rule 6.1 of Examination bye laws and rule 12 Affiliation bye laws.

- 19. The school has to constitute a committee for protection of woman from **sexual harassment** at the wo abide by the guidelines and norms prescribed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P. Criminal 1992 Vishaskha and other State of Rajasthan and other delivered on 13.8.1997 mentioned under rule
- 20. Each school affiliated with the Board shall frame **Service Rules** for its employees which will be as per the state/U.T., if the Act makes adoption of the same obligatory, otherwise as per Service Rules given Laws. Further, **Service contract** will be entered with each employee as per the provisions in the Educ state/ U.T., or as given in Appendix III, if not obligatory as per the State Education Act.
- 21. Pay and allowances to staff should be revised time to time to bring it at par with that to State Govern Salary and service conditions of staff should be provided in accordance with rule no. 3.3 (v) and rule appended below:
 - a. The school in India must pay salaries and admissible allowances to the staff not less than categories of employees in the State Government schools or as per scales etc. prescribed by the India." Further, the service conditions as per Rule 10 and Rules 24 to 49 of Affiliation Bye-Laws als
 - b. Salary should be paid through Electronic Clearing Service (ECS) from the date of first appointme on probation.
- 22. As per Rule 13.3 and 13.3 (i), the school shall supply information and returns called for by the Board/s Government/Local Authority within the prescribed time given for its furnishing to the authority concernshould prepare its annual report containing comprehensive information including name, address postal

- number of students and status of fulfillment of norms of affiliation Bye-Laws and upload same on the v 15th September of every year.
- 23. Continuous **sponsoring of students at Board examination** is to be made as per rule 13.12 (iv), Fail lead to suo moto withdrawal of the affiliation of the school for Secondary and Senior Secondary Exam case may be.
- 24. As per rule 13.12 (ii), no affiliated school shall endeavour to present the candidates who are not on its present the candidates of its unaffiliated Branch/School to any of the Board's Examinations.
- 25. Running of classes of **coaching institutions** in the school premises in the pretext of providing coachi for various examinations is not approved by the board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
- 26. As per rule no. 8.2 and 13.11, facilities for physically challenged student should be adequately provide school shall promote inclusion of student with disabilities/special needs in the normal school as per professions with Disabilities Act 1995'.
- 27. **Health, sanitation and fire safety** should be adequately equipped in accordance with rule no. 3.3 (vi rule 23.11.
- 28. **School infrastructure and teachers for examinations** conducted by the board and evaluation of an should be made available as per rule no. 13.4.
- 29. As per rule no. 8.8 (iv & v), every affiliated school to develop their own website containing comprehen such as affiliation status, details of infrastructure, details of teachers, number of students, address-post telephone nos. etc.

- 30. As per rule no. 3.3 h (vi), every school should organize at least one week training programme for year in association with any teachers training institute recognized by the State or Central Governn agency identified by the Board.
- 31. Every secondary and senior secondary school shall appoint a person on full time basis for perforr a Health Wellness teacher as per rule 53.5.
- 32. Strict adherence to the provisions of Wild Life Protection Act while procuring plants and animals for laboratories by the school must be made in accordance with circular no 03 dated 21 May 2013.
- 33. As per rule 15.1 (d), the school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by Ne and text books publishing by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle classes as far as practicable or exercis while selecting books of private publishers. The content must be scrutinized to preclude any object that hurts the feelings of any class, community, gender, religious group in society. If found prescrib such content, the school will have to take responsibility of such content. Provided that the school such books prescribed by it on its website with the written declaration duly signed by the Manager to the effect that they have gone through the contents of the books prescribed by the school and c responsibility.
- 34. As per RTE act 2009 and Chapter IX rule No. 53.2.2(a) and 53.3, a teacher appointed to teach C to VIII should pass in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET)/ State Teacher Eligibility Test (TE the appropriate Government in accordance with the guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose
- 35. The school should keep a copy of Affiliation/ Examination Bye Laws for reference purpose and alvisit CBSE websites www.cbseaff.nic.in & www.cbse.nic.in for updates.
- 36. 5-6 names of persons not below the rank of Principal of Sr. Secondary School affiliated with the E recommended so that two of them may be approved by the Board as its nominee in the School M Committee. Of these 2-3 may be Principal of KV/JNV.
- 37. The school will create Reserve Fund as per the requirement of the Affiliation Bye Laws.
- 38. It is mandatory for every affiliated school to become a member in the local Sahodaya of CBSE sc
- 39. The Board would not allow any transfer of property/sale of school by one society/ Management/ T Society/Management/Trust through agreement/sale deed and the school shall not be closed dowr premises. In case such transaction is effected explicitly or implicitly the Board shall withdraw its af immediate effect.
- 40. The school should not start Class XI/XII without written approval of the Board. The Board shall no for any consequences in case class XI/XII is started without following the Affiliation Bye Laws and prior approval of the Board.
- 41. The school will apply for further Extension of Provisional Affiliation 'on online' through www.cbseaf prescribed fee of Rs. 50,000/- and other essential documents before 30th June of the preceding y expiry of the date of provisional affiliation otherwise penalty @ Rs 20,000/- p.m. subject to maximu 00,000/- will be charged for late execution of application.
- 42. The school will open CBSE pattern classes IX w.e.f. **01.04.2018**. Accordingly, 1st Batch of class will be appeared at the Board's Examination to be held in the year **2020**.
